BUDGET HIGHLIGHTS

The FY/12 General Fund budget reflects an overall decrease of 4.7% or \$43 thousand below the original FY/11 level. The approved budget is \$870 thousand. The decrease is due to a reduction in the cost of risk assessments. Funding in the Mayor's Office provides for six positions, the same level as FY/11.
