DRAFT MEETING/HEARING MINUTES

CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order by Chair Kelsey Curran at 5:38 P.M. on October 22, 2014 with six voting Board members present: Jens Deichmann, Augustine Grace, Dona Upson, Kelsey Curran, Jane Cudney-Black, and Robert Goldstein; and two non-voting members present: Lenton Malry and Margaret Nieto. Not present was Member Deborah Stover.

Chair Curran asked that, because many pleadings related to the Smith's 4th Street Motion Hearing were filed later in the day, Wednesday, October 22, 2014, would the Board like to hold the Motion Hearing on the same evening or continue at a later date? After discussion, the Board decided to continue with the Motion Hearing as scheduled.

Item #1 Approval of Agenda (Chair)

Board Attorney Felicia Orth asked Chair Curran to add a discussion of the pleading **Petitioners' Request to Air Board to Disclose Possible Conflicts of Interest and Motion to Disqualify** that was filed the morning of October 22, 2014. A motion to add a discussion of that item to the agenda as Item #2 and approve the agenda as amended was made by Member Deichmann and seconded by Vice Chair Cudney-Black. The motion was approved unanimously by a vote of 6-0.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Hearing none, Hearing Officer Orth denied the motion.

Attorneys for all parties presented arguments in support of and against the Motions from Smith's Food and Drug, Inc. and the City of Albuquerque Environmental Health Department.

After extensive discussion, a motion to grant the Motions for Summary Judgment was made by Member Deichmann, seconded by Member Upson. The motion passed by a vote of 4-2 (For: Deichmann, Upson, Curran, Cudney-Black; Against: Grace, Goldstein).

Because the Board granted the Motions for Summary Judgment and dismissal of the Petition for Hearing, the Hearing on the Merits initially set for November 12-13, 2014, will be cancelled.
