## ALBUQUERQUE - BERNALILLO COUNTY AIR QUALITY CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. #2016-2 DETERMINING REASONABLE NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETINGS OF THE ALBUQUERQUE-BERNALILLO COUNTY AIR QUALITY CONTROL BOARD

WHEREAS, the Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Air Quality Control Board met in 6 7 regular session in the Vincent E. Griego Chambers, Basement Level of the Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Government Center at One Civic Plaza NW, near the intersection of 5<sup>th</sup> Street 8 9 and Marquette Avenue NW, Albuquerque, New Mexico 87102, on November 16, 2016, at 5:30 10 PM as required by law and with notice as specified in AOCB Resolution No. #2015-4; and WHEREAS, Section 10-15-1(B) of the Open Meetings Act (NMSA 1978, Sections 10-11 15-1 to -4) states that, except as may be otherwise provided in the Constitution of New Mexico 12 or the provisions of the Open Meetings Act, all meetings of a quorum of members of any board, 13 council, commission, administrative adjudicatory body or other policymaking body of any state 14 or local public agency held for the purpose of formulating public policy, discussing public 15 business or for the purpose of taking any action within the authority of or the delegated authority 16 of such body, are declared to be public meetings open to the public at all times; and 17 WHEREAS, any meetings subject to the Open Meetings Act at which the discussion or 18 adoption of any proposed resolution, rule, regulation or formal action occurs shall be held only 19 after reasonable notice to the public; and 20 WHEREAS, Section 10-15-1(D) of the Open Meetings Act requires the Albuquerque-21 Bernalillo County Air Quality Control Board to determine at least annually what constitutes 22

23 reasonable notice of its public meetings; and

Whereas, the *Public Boards, Commissions and Committees Ordinance*, Chapter 2,
 Article 6, Section 1-4, (B)(2) Revised Ordinances of Albuquerque, New Mexico 1994 (ROA

1994) requires that: "Reasonable notice shall be given to the public prior to any meeting of any
public board, commission or committee. At least once a year, each public board, commission or
committee shall determine what is reasonable notice to the public; provided that in no event shall
notice be less than the notice required for Council (i.e. Albuquerque City Council) meetings.";
and

6 Whereas, the Joint Air Quality Control Board Ordinance, Chapter 9, Article 5, Section 7 1-3, (C) ROA 1994 and Bernalillo County Ordinances, Section 30-32(c), require that: "The Board shall meet in public facilities with public seating available. The Board shall meet monthly 8 if a quorum is available unless a meeting is unnecessary or delayed for good reason. The Board 9 shall hold a minimum of six monthly meetings a year. Special additional meetings may be held 10 as needed. Notice of time, place and agenda of meetings shall be published according to the 11 12 requirements of law. Meetings, work sessions and hearings shall be open to the public." 13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE AIR QUALITY CONTROL

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE AIR QUALITY CONTROL
14 BOARD HEREBY ADOPTS THESE PUBLIC NOTICE REQUIREMENTS WHICH ARE
15 CONSISTENT WITH THOSE OF THE ALBUQUERQUE CITY COUNCIL AS
16 ADOPTED ON SEPTEMBER 19, 2016 BY THE COUNCIL IN RESOLUTION R-16-99,
17 ENACTMENT NO. R-2016-083.:

Section 1. Location of Meetings. Meetings of the Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Air Quality Control Board shall normally be held in the Vincent E. Griego Chambers, Basement Level of the Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Government Center at One Civic Plaza NW, near the intersection of 5<sup>th</sup> Street and Marquette Avenue NW, Albuquerque, New Mexico 87102, or as indicated in the meeting notice.



Section 2. Regular Meetings. Unless otherwise specified, regular meetings shall be held

each month on the second Wednesday of the month at 5:30 PM. The agenda will be available at
least seventy-two hours prior to the meeting from the Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Air
Quality Control Board Liaison, whose office is located in the Albuquerque-Bernalillo County
Government Center at One Civic Plaza NW, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, Room 3023, near the intersection of 5<sup>th</sup>
Street and Marquette Avenue NW, Albuquerque, New Mexico 87102. The agenda will also be
posted on the Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Air Quality Control Board's website at
https://www.cabq.gov/airquality/air-quality-control-board.

8 Section 3. Other Regular Meetings. Notice of regular meetings other than those 9 described in Section 2 of this resolution will be given ten days in advance of the meeting date. 10 The notice will include a copy of the agenda or information on how a copy of the agenda may be 11 obtained. If not included in the notice, the agenda will be available at least seventy-two hours 12 before the meeting and posted on the Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Air Quality Control 13 Board's website at https://www.cabq.gov/airquality/air-quality-control-board.

14 Section 4. Special Meetings. Special meetings may be called by the Chair of the 15 Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Air Quality Control Board or a majority of the members upon 16 seventy-two hours' notice. The notice for a special meeting shall include an agenda for the 17 meeting or information on how a copy of the agenda may be obtained. The agenda shall be 18 available at least seventy-two hours before the meeting and posted on the Albuquerque-19 Bernalillo County Air Quality Control Board's website at https://www.cabq.gov/airquality/air-20 quality-control-board.

Section 5. Emergency Meetings. Emergency meetings will be called only under unforeseen circumstances that demand immediate action to protect the health, safety and property of citizens or to protect the public body from substantial financial loss. The

Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Air Quality Control Board will avoid emergency meetings 1 2 whenever possible. Emergency meetings may be called by the Chair of the Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Air Quality Control Board or a majority of the members with twenty-four 3 hours' prior notice, unless threat of personal injury or property damage requires less notice. The 4 notice for all emergency meetings shall include an agenda for the meeting or information on how 5 the public may obtain a copy of the agenda. Within ten days of taking action on an emergency 6 7 matter, the Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Air Quality Control Board will notify the Attorney General's Office. 8

Section 6. Regular Meeting Notice Requirements. For the purposes of regular meetings 9 described in Sections 2 and 3 of this resolution, notice requirements are met by posting a notice 10 of the date, time, place and agenda in the lobby of the Albuquerque-Bernalillo County 11 Government Center at One Civic Plaza NW, near the intersection of 5<sup>th</sup> Street and Marquette 12 Avenue NW, Albuquerque, New Mexico 87102 and by posting on the Albuquerque-Bernalillo 13 County Air Quality Control Board's website at https://www.cabq.gov/airquality/air-quality-14 control-board. An annual calendar with notice of the date, time and location of the Albuquerque-15 16 Bernalillo County Air Quality Control Board's meetings shall also be published in one or more 17 newspapers of general circulation in Albuquerque. For regular meetings other than those 18 described in Section 2 of this resolution, notice of the date, time and location of the meeting shall also be published in one or more newspapers of general circulation in Albuquerque at least ten 19 days in advance of the meeting. The Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Air Quality Control Board 20 Liaison shall also provide copies of the agendas to those broadcast stations licensed by the 21 Federal Communications Commission and newspapers of general circulation in Albuquerque, 22 provided these entities have made a written request for notice of public meetings. The 23

Department may also provide notice to the State Records Center for publication in the New
 Mexico Register.

3 Section 7. Special and Emergency Meeting Notice Requirements. For the purposes of special meetings and emergency meetings described in Sections 4 and 5 of this resolution, notice 4 requirements are met by posting a notice of the date, time, place and agenda in the lobby of the 5 6 Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Government Center at One Civic Plaza NW, near the intersection of 5<sup>th</sup> Street and Marquette Avenue NW, Albuquerque, New Mexico 87102 and by 7 posting on the Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Air Quality Control Board's website at 8 9 https://www.cabq.gov/airquality/air-quality-control-board. The Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Air Quality Control Board Liaison shall also provide copies of the agendas to those broadcast 10 stations licensed by the Federal Communications Commission and newspapers of general 11 circulation in Albuquerque, provided these entities have made a written request for notice of 12 public meetings. 13

14 Section 8. Hearing Notice. For the purpose of hearings where testimony is sought from proponents, opponents and interested parties, notice requirements shall be in accordance with the 15 New Mexico State Air Quality Control Act and Air Board procedural regulations. The Air Board 16 17 staff shall provide written notice to newspapers of general circulation in Albuquerque and Bernalillo County at least thirty (30) days prior to the date of all hearings involving the adoption 18 19 of, amendment to, or the repeal of a regulation of the Air Board. The Air Board staff shall also 20 post notice on the Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Air Quality Control Board's website at https://www.cabq.gov/airquality/air-quality-control-board if technically feasible at the time. 21 22 Notice of a hearing of the Air Board can be combined with the notice for a meeting. In addition, 23 notice of proposed rulemaking shall be published in the New Mexico Register at least thirty (30)

1 days prior to the date of the hearing.

Section 9. Cancellations and Changes of Venue and Meeting Time. Cancellations and 2 changes to meeting times and locations may be announced at prior meetings of the Air Board or 3 following notice requirements of this Resolution. 4 Section 10. Accessibility. In addition to the information specified above, all notices shall include 5 the following language: 6 "NOTICE TO PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES: If you have a disability and 7 require special assistance to participate in this meeting, please contact the 8 Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Air Quality Control Board Liaison as soon as 9 possible before the meeting date at 505-768-2601. Those in need of hearing 10 assistance may call 711." 11 Section 11. Closed Meetings. The Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Air Quality Control 12 Board may close a meeting to the public only if the subject matter of such discussion or action is 13 excepted from the open meeting requirement under Section 10-15-1(H) of the Open Meetings 14 Act. 15 Section 11(a). If any meeting is closed during an open meeting, such closure shall be 16 approved by a majority vote of a quorum of the Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Air Quality 17 Control Board taken during the open meeting. The authority for the closed meeting and the 18 subjects to be discussed shall be stated with reasonable specificity in the motion to close and the 19 vote of each individual member on the motion to close shall be recorded in the minutes. Only 20 those subjects specified in the motion may be discussed in the closed meeting. 21 Section 11(b). If a closed meeting is conducted when the Albuquerque-Bernalillo County 22 Air Quality Control Board is not in an open meeting, the closed meeting shall not be held until 23

public notice, appropriate under the circumstances, stating the specific provision of law 1 authorizing the closed meeting and the subjects to be discussed with reasonable specificity, is 2 given to the members and to the general public. 3 Section 11(c). Following completion of any closed meeting, the minutes of the open 4 meeting that was closed, or the minutes of the next open meeting if the closed meeting was 5 separately scheduled, shall state whether the matters discussed in the closed meeting were 6 limited only to those specified in the motion or notice for closure. 7 Section 11(d). Except as provided in Section 10-15-1(H) of the Open Meetings Act, any 8 action taken as a result of discussions in a closed meeting shall be made by vote of the 9 Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Air Quality Control Board in an open public meeting. 10

WHEREAS, Section 10-15-1(D) of the Open Meetings Act requires the
Albuquerque City Council to determine at least annually what constitutes
reasonable notice of its public meetings.

24 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF 25 ALBUQUERQUE:

1 Section 1. Location of Meetings. Meetings of the full Council shall 2 normally be held in the Vincent E. Griego Chambers, Basement Level of the Albuquerque/Bernalillo County Government Center at One Civic Plaza NW, 3 near the intersection of 5<sup>th</sup> Street and Marquette Ave. NW, Albuquerque, New 4 5 Mexico 87102.

6 Section 2. Regular Meetings. Meetings will be held each month on the 7 dates specified by Council resolution, as provided in Section 2-1-1 ROA 1994. Generally, Council meetings are held at 5:00 p.m. on the first and third 8 9 Mondays of each month. The final agenda will be available 72 hours prior to 10 the meeting from the Clerk of the Council, whose office is located in the 11 Albuquerque/Bernalillo County Government Center, One Civic Plaza NW, 9th Floor, Suite 9087. The Clerk of the Council shall post, if possible, a draft listing 12 13 of agenda items to come before the full Council on the Albuquerque City 14 Council web site (www.cabg.gov/council) at least five days prior to the 15 meeting, subject to revision until the agenda is deemed final.

16 Section 3. Special Meetings. Special meetings may be called by the 17 President of the Council or by three Councilors upon 72 hours' notice. The notice shall include information on how members of the public may obtain a 18 19 copy of the agenda. The agenda shall be available to the public at least 72 20 hours before any special meeting.

Section 4. Emergency Meetings. Emergency meetings will be called in accordance with Section 2-1-4 ROA 1994. The Council will avoid emergency 22 meetings whenever possible. Emergency meetings may be called by the President of the Council upon 24 hours' notice, unless the threat of personal injury or property damage requires less notice. The notice for all emergency meetings shall include an agenda for the meeting or information on how the public may obtain a copy of the agenda.

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28 Section 5. <u>Committee Meetings</u>. City Council Committee meetings may 29 be called by the chair of a committee upon 72 hours' notice. The notice shall 30 include information on how members of the public may obtain a copy of the 31 agenda. The agenda shall be available to the public at least 72 hours before 32 any committee meeting. Council Committees do not hold emergency 33 meetings.

1 Section 6. Location of Notice for all Meetings. For the purpose of 2 meetings described in Sections 2, 3, 4 and 5 of this resolution, notice 3 requirements are met by posting a notice of the date, time, location and the agenda in the lobby of the Albuquerque/Bernalillo County Government Center 4 5 and posted on the Albuquerque City Council web site (www.cabq.gov/council). 6 The Clerk of the Council shall also provide copies of the agendas to those 7 broadcast stations licensed by the Federal Communications Commission and 8 newspapers of general circulation in Albuquerque, which entities have made a 9 written request for notice of public meetings. Such notice shall be provided to 10 the Government Access Cable TV Channel.

11 Section 7. <u>Accessibility</u>. Public documents, including the agendas and 12 minutes, can be provided in various accessible formats. Please contact the 13 Clerk of the Council at the Council Office if a certain type of accessible format 14 is needed. In addition to the information specified above, all notices shall 15 include the following language:

16 "NOTICE TO PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES: If you have a disability and

19 Those in need of hearing assistance may call 711."
