

Re: 20.11.2 NMAC, Fees

The Air Quality Division of the City of Albuquerque's Environmental Health Department is proposing that the Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Air Quality Control Board amend regulation **20.11.2 NMAC, Fees**. We are interested in your input as a stakeholder and would appreciate your review and comments prior to finalizing the draft. The objective of 20.11.2 NMAC is to establish fees sufficient to cover the reasonable costs of implementing and enforcing the requirements of the Federal Clean Air Act; the New Mexico Air Quality Control Act, Chapter 74, Article 2, NMSA 1978; the City of Albuquerque and Bernalillo County Joint Air Quality Control Board Ordinances; and the Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Air Quality Control Board Regulations.

The scope of 20.11.2 NMAC applies to: every person required to submit a source registration application pursuant to 20.11.40 NMAC, *Source Registration* or other board regulation; every person required to submit a permit application pursuant to: 20.11.20 NMAC, *Fugitive Dust Control*; 20.11.41 NMAC, *Authority to Construct*; 20.11.42 NMAC, *Operating Permits*; 20.11.60 NMAC, *Permitting in Nonattainment Areas*; 20.11.61 NMAC, *Prevention of Significant Deterioration*; or other board regulation; every person with a valid source registration or permit issued pursuant to: 20.11.20 NMAC; 20.11.40 NMAC; 20.11.41 NMAC; 20.11.42 NMAC; 20.11.60 NMAC; or 20.11.61 NMAC; every person who submits a permit modification pursuant to: 20.11.41 NMAC, *Authority to Construct*; 20.11.60 NMAC, *Permitting in Nonattainment Areas*; or 20.11.61 NMAC, *Prevention of Significant Deterioration*; every person who submits a technical permit revision pursuant to 20.11.41 NMAC, *Authority to Construct*; every person who submits an administrative revision to either a source registration issued pursuant to 20.11.40 NMAC, *Source Registration*, or a permit issued pursuant to 20.11.41 NMAC, *Authority to Construct*; every person required to submit a notification regarding removal of regulated asbestos containing material pursuant to 20.11.64 NMAC, *Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants for Stationary Sources*; every person who submits a request for a variance pursuant to 20.11.7 NMAC, *Variance Procedure*; every person who submits a request for a hearing before the board unless otherwise exempted; every person required to submit an air quality impact analysis pursuant to the Revised Ordinances of Albuquerque 1994, Section 14-16-3-14, *Air Quality Impact Regulations*; and every person who submits a request for professional or administrative services or copies of public records.
