ADOPTION OF THE 2014 ADMISSIONS AND CONTINUED OCCUPANCY POLICY

WHEREAS, federal regulations require the Albuquerque Housing Authority to review and update the Admissions and Continued Occupancy Policy (ACOP) for the Public Housing and Section 8 Rental Assistance Programs as needed;

WHEREAS, the 2014 edition of the ACOP has been revised and updated and the Albuquerque Housing Authority is desirous of adopting the revised and updated policies, and;

WHEREAS, the proposed 2014 edition of the ACOP was posted online in 2014 for public review, a notice was posted in the AHA office lobby, and printed in the Albuquerque Journal, to actively seek public comment on the plan and a public hearing was held to gather public input, and the comments received were seriously considered and changes were made by AHA staff;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE AHA BOARD OF HOUSING COMMISSIONERS, the governing body of the AHA that:

The Board finds that AHA needs to adopt an updated Admissions and Continued Occupancy Policy (ACOP) this year. A copy of the 2014 edition of the ACOP is attached as Exhibit A and is hereby adopted for the use by the Albuquerque Housing Authority pursuant to the Rules and Regulations promulgated by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to include the Quality Housing and Work Responsibility Act of 1998 as amended, and is effective May 1, 2014.
