The RG65 Class began in Buenos Aires, Argentina in the 1950s. The “R” stands for “Radio,” the “G” for Juan Gherzi, who initiated the class, and the “65” for the size of the boats, which are all 65 centimeters (about 25 ½ inches) long. The Class rules give designers and builders wide latitude in the ways they strive for the fastest boat: the only other restrictions are on the amount and height of the boat’s sails.

Tingley Beach is located at 1800 Tingley Drive SW (south of Central). Hours are sunrise to sunset every day of the year. There is no access fee to use Tingley Beach, which is a facility of the City of Albuquerque’s BioPark. Adults 12 and older must have a valid NM fishing license to fish at the lakes.
