[How Much Will I Get Paid?]

Presiding Judges

- ◆ \$200 for serving on Election Day

Judges and Clerks

- ◆ \$175 for serving on Election Day

[Who Can Be A Poll Worker?]

To be a poll worker, you must be:

- ◆ At least 18 years old
- ◆ A United States citizen
- ◆ A registered voter in Albuquerque, living within the Albuquerque city limits
- ◆ Able to speak and read English or be bilingual
- ◆ Cannot be a City of Albuquerque employee.

- ◆ Serve on Election Day 6:00 a.m.-10:00 p.m.
- ◆ Assist with setting up polling locations.
- ◆ Assist with the breakdown of polling locations.
- ◆ Process voters and provide support
- ◆ Be competent with computers and comfortable using computer systems.
