Meeting Purpose

The City of Albuquerque in cooperation with the New Mexico Department of Transportation and the Federal Highway Administration is sponsoring this meeting to discuss proposed safety improvements on Zuni Road between Washington Street SE and Central Avenue NE. All interested parties are encouraged to attend and provide comments, concerns, and suggestions regarding the project.


Project Summary

The Zuni Road Improvements Project is proposed for Zuni Road between Washington Street and Central Avenue, a length of approximately 2.9 miles. The Zuni Road Improvements Project would provide operational improvements for pedestrians, bicycles, and vehicles on Zuni Road. This project proposes to reduce the number of driving lanes to provide for widened sidewalks, add bicycle lanes, and reduce vehicle speeds. Zuni Road from Washington Street to San Mateo Boulevard would have 4 driving lanes (2 lanes in each direction), bicycle lanes, and a raised median. Zuni Road from San Mateo Boulevard to Central Avenue would have 3 lanes (1 driving lane in each direction and a center turn lane) and bicycle lanes. Along the entire corridor, sidewalks would be 5-6 feet wide, and possibly wider in some areas. The existing curb and gutter would be replaced with new curb and gutter. The existing pavement would be milled and overlaid and restriped for the new lane configurations. Existing traffic signals and intersections would be modified where needed to address Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards, accommodate the new lane geometry, and accommodate the added width where right-turn lanes are proposed. Landscaping, roadway lighting, storm drainage adjustments, and bus shelters would be developed as necessary.


