

1 WHEREAS, the noise, vibration, and biological studies completed as part of
2 the Wilson and Company report show that the effects to the adjacent
3 properties within the Los Poblanos Historic District are minimal and remain
4 within State and Federal Guidelines with Montañó Road configured as a 4 lane
5 facility between Coors Boulevard and 4th Street; and

6 WHEREAS, the Second Judicial District Court, County of Bernalillo, State
7 of New Mexico has determined that the City of Albuquerque has met all City
8 policies and dissolved the preliminary injunction delaying the City of
9 Albuquerque from reconfiguring Montañó Road between Coors and 4th Street
10 to 4 lanes; and

11 WHEREAS, it is necessary and socially and economically prudent to
12 expand the use of the Montañó Bridge and Road between Coors and 4th Street
13 to its capacity of four general purpose lanes as soon as possible.

14 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY
15 OF ALBUQUERQUE THAT:

16 Section 1. Montañó Road between Coors Boulevard and 4th Street shall be
17 operated as a four general purpose lane facility throughout the corridor or any
18 portion thereof as soon as possible.
