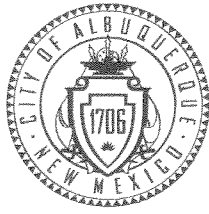

1 ORDINANCE
2 IMMEDIATELY SUSPENDING THE OPERATION OF THE POLICE OVERSIGHT
3 COMMISSION PENDING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A NEW OVERSIGHT
4 SYSTEM.

5 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
6 CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE:

7 Section 1. LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS.

8 (A) Effective oversight of the police force is critical to public safety and
9 confidence and, therefore, the City Council has enacted a Police Oversight
10 Ordinance to provide oversight of the police force and process citizen
11 complaints.

12 (B) The City of Albuquerque deserves a highly professional well trained
13 Police Department; however, the Police Oversight Commission (the "POC")
14 has not proven to be an effective oversight entity as documented by the report
15 from the United States Department of Justice dated April 10, 2014.

16 Section 2. SUSPENSION OF THE POLICE OVERSIGHT COMMISSION. All
17 functions, powers, and duties of the Police Oversight Commission established
18 by Sections 9-4-1-4 and 9-4-1-5 of the Revised Ordinances of Albuquerque are
19 hereby suspended until such time as the City Council determines those
20 functions should begin again or enacts a different or altered oversight
21 process. During the suspension, the Independent Review Officer (IRO) shall
22 continue to receive, investigate and evaluate citizen complaints and officer
23 involved shootings without oversight by or the involvement of the existing
24 Police Oversight Commission.

25 Section 3. The determinations of the IRO shall, if requested, be reviewed
26 by the City pursuant to the Police Oversight Ordinance. The City shall assign

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1 the review to a contract hearing officer qualified pursuant to the terms of the
2 Administrative Hearings Ordinance to conduct a whole record review of the
3 determinations of the IRO.

4 Section 4. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, paragraph, sentence,
5 clause, word or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or
6 unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not
7 affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance. The Council
8 hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each section,
9 paragraph, sentence, clause, word or phrase thereof irrespective of any
10 provision being declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid.

11 Section 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect five days
12 after publication by title and general summary.
