Statement

On March 23 I came home from work to find a vehicle parked in front of my house and a man exiting the entrance way of our rental. He proceeded to the car parked in front of me a drove off. I got the tags and then ran inside to make sure my husband was safe. About 15-20 minutes before I arrived at home and saw the car, my husband had walked next door to help a neighbor for about 10 minutes. Within that time our home was burglarized and all of our valuables had been stolen (all of our most sentimental items were taken, and we are definitely not "well-of" people to begin with, so to us it was EVERYTHING). When my husband had gotten home he did not initially notice the burglary had taken place and went back to what he was doing in the kitchen. Right before I arrived the man and the car (red nissan altima tags 173 skc) who were involved in the burglary, had come back for the rest of the items he did not get the first time (they were gathered and ready to be taken out of our house by the intruder). The man was actively trying to enter the premises and was told to leave by my husband.

The initial police officer taking our report never even wrote the tag number to this car in our report. I found this out after many calls inquiring about our case. After seeing the same vehicle days later, less than a mile down the street from our home, I made another call to police and THEY DID NOTHING! After a few weeks of frustration and no detective assigned to my case, I began calling all departments until someone was able to put me in touch with a Sergeant. This Sergeant immediately took up our case and put Det. Jonae Lujan on it. Since getting in contact with her, I have felt a million times better about our situation. We got nothing but the run around from everyone else and did nearly all of the investigative work ourselves (this includes locating the shops that had seen our stolen items come in with the suspect and finding the vehicle being cleaned out over the course of 6hrs just a couple days from our burglary and less than a mile down the street). Det. Lujan was able to trace the tag of the car to a burglary case on the west side just one month before our burglary, something no one had even looked at in the weeks following our case. She had us come in for a photo lineup in which my husband positively IDed the man involved. She has been in contact with us and even gave me her email and work cell so that I could send photos of the vehicle and other pertinent information to her. She has been amazing and has brought us much more hope about our situation. We have been living in Albuquerque for almost two years now and it is very apparent that many of the government funded offices (esp. APD) are lacking in resources, especially during the crime spikes that come about when the warm weather arrives. Det. Lujan has gone above and beyond for us and continues to keep in contact and keep me informed. She has been communicating with the DA to keep apprise of our case and I cannot thank her enough for her services. You guys need more detectives and officers like her. I appreciate being treated like a person and a victim rather than a statistic. Even if nothing comes of our case now, at least I know we had someone in our corner.

What Outcome are you Seeking?

I would like for Det. Jonae Lujan to get some sort of commendation for her work. She goes above and beyond and is a true asset to this city's police department.
