I concur with CPOA investigator Chris Davidson's findings of Sustained for SOP violation 3-13-3(4-a) and with Commander M. Runyan's recommendation of sustained Violation not based on original complaint for SOP section 2-40-G (3). I do not concur with investigator Chris Davidson's recommendation of discipline of a 40-hour suspension for Officer [REDACTED] C [REDACTED]'s sustained violation of SOP section 3-13-4(4-a).

The interpretation is not accurate as it pertains to analysis and recommendation for progressive discipline. The CPOA determined the involved officer should receive a 40-hour suspension due to a prior sanction 7 sustained firearms discharge, SOP 1-1-4F1. Officer [REDACTED] C [REDACTED] received a verbal reprimand for this violation. SOP 1-1-4F1 is unrelated, different and a separate SOP violation and cannot be used for progressive discipline in this case since the circumstances are not the same.
