Proposed Changes affecting Model Year

- Clarify New Car Exemption of 4 years
 - test still required at title transfer, then biennial
- Return 1985 and older to biennial test
 - consistent with City and County enabling ordinances
- Exempt Vehicles that are 35 years old
 - consistent with state collector car and horseless carriage



Proposed Changes affecting Fuel Type

- Begin OBD testing of 1998 and newer Diesels
 - effective January 1st of year following ozone standard revision
- Begin OBD testing of gas/electric Hybrids
 - existing exemptions honored until title transfer, then biennial

Proposed Changes to the test procedure

- Discontinue rev-up/ smoke test on OBD
- Visual tamper check for CATs on OBD
- ♦ Limit gas cap check to 1975 -2005 models
- Allow limited mobile testing of OBD fleets



Proposed Changes to the Regulation Structure

- Remove redundant sections and make it easier to read and understand
- Reformat consistent with other AQ regulations
- Move enforcement and appeals sections from Procedures Manual to Regulation
- **♦** Change Procedures Manual from Regulatory document to technical guidance document
