
Be a Summer Assistant at Cherry Hills Library

Read to the Dogs

Would your child like a patient, attentive friend to read to? *Read to the Dogs* provides an opportunity for your child to practice reading out loud without fear of judgment. Each time a child reads to one of the dogs he or she receives a sticker with that dog's picture to put on a special bookmark. All dogs in the program are certified therapy dogs (certified through a battery of disposition tests and intense training) provided through Albuquerque's Southwest Canine Corps of Volunteers. It's a great way for children to gain confidence in their reading!







Your NoveList

Looking for a good book? Use the NoveList database to find readalikes; to look up all an author's books in chronological order; to find titles on awards, honors, and recommended lists; and even to find book discussion guides. NoveList can be searched by author, title, series title, even plot! And now you can save titles to your Personal List, before you lose all memory of the books from your evanescent mental list!

From the NoveList homepage, choose *Sign Into My NoveList* from the Tools sidebar. (If you don't have a NoveList account, just click on "I'm a new user" at the top of the page and enter the

required information to open an account.) Once inside, you can search NoveList, by clicking on either the *Search Our Database* or *Browse Lists* tabs. Upon discovering a book you want to remember, click on *Add To List* at the top right-hand corner of the page. Once you are done adding to the list, click on *View List*. Select all the titles you want to save from your list, and click on *Submit*. You will be asked to name your list

NoveList is a great resource, easily accessible from the library's homepage. Ask at the Information Desk for help using this database.


