<b>Library Materials</b>	\$3,000,000	Purchase Library Materials including books, digital media (books, music, video and audiobooks), media (DVDs, CDs, portable digital devices), databases, periodicals, electronic resources, and other needed materials to meet customer demand for new information, replace outdated material, and provide educational and recreational materials for all ages at all libraries. May also include construction, landscaping and signage.
<b>International District Library</b>	\$5,500,000	Plan, design, develop, construct, equip, automate, furnish, landscape and acquire books, media and equipment for a public library in the international district.
<b>Library Projects - Council District 1</b>	\$75,000	Acquire property, study, plan, design, develop, construct, reconstruct, renovate, rehabilitate, modernize, preserve, automate, upgrade, landscape and otherwise improve, and acquire books, media and equipment for public libraries that benefit District 1.
<b>Library Projects - Council District 3</b>	\$100,000	Acquire property, study, plan, design, develop, construct, reconstruct, renovate, rehabilitate, modernize, preserve, automate, upgrade, landscape and otherwise improve, and to acquire books, media and equipment for public libraries that will benefit Council District 3.
<b>1% for Public Art</b>	\$90,000	As provided in the City's "Art in Municipal Places" ordinance, one percent of each bond purpose shall be provided for Public Art.
