

## PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION BONDS

<b>Revenue Vehicles Replacement / Expansion (Transit)</b>	\$2,750,000	Purchase revenue vehicles and acquire associated equipment. These funds are required to obtain the federal match.
<b>West Side Park &amp; Ride Improvements</b>	\$1,250,000	Acquire land, design, construct, renovate and otherwise improve the Park and Ride facility on Central and Unser including but not limited to: pavement, sidewalks, lighting, landscaping, upgraded shelter, and electronic schedule displays.
<b>West Side Transit Facility</b>	\$500,000	Construct covered storage structures to protect City assets (revenue vehicles deadheaded at the facility) from damaging climatic elements. Almost \$2 M has been received from Congress for this project. These GO Bond funds are required to obtain federal matching funds. These funds will complete the project.
<b>Bus Shelter Rehabilitation/Upgrade</b>	\$2,000,000	Rehabilitate, upgrade and design/construct bus shelters and associated equipment including, but not limited to, route signage and other passenger directional equipment and technologies. These funds may be used to leverage private contributions.
<b>Transit Facility Rehabilitation</b>	\$200,000	Plan, design, rehabilitate / remodel, renovate and purchase related equipment for existing transit facilities.
<b>Maintenance Equipment Upgrade (Transit)</b>	\$250,000	Acquire equipment to maintain revenue vehicles.
<b>Transit Security Equipment Upgrade</b>	\$50,000	Acquire security related equipment and install associated materials including, but not limited to, automated vehicle locator components, security cameras, power supply units, recording equipment, security management software, video monitors, conduit, cabling and electrical connectors, in transit facilities, structures and revenue vehicles.
<b>Nob Hill Parking Structure - Location &amp; Financial Feasibility Study</b>	\$100,000	Acquire land, plan, design and construct a parking structure in the Nob Hill area.
<b>Parking Facilities Rehabilitation &amp; Upgrade</b>	\$150,000	Rehabilitate parking facilities, upgrade related equipment and replace antiquated parking meters.
<b>1% for Public Art</b>	\$73,000	As provided in the City's "Art in Municipal Places" ordinance, one percent of each bond purpose shall be provided for Public Art.
