## Procedures to Obtain Homeowner Permits for Drivepads and Sidewalk

## Homeowner:

- 1. Must Be The Property Owner.
- 2. Homeowner <u>Cannot</u> Cut or Replace Curb and Gutter; Must Be Done By Contractor. Contractor Must Obtain Permit For Curb And Gutter Before Homeowner Is Issued Permit For Drivepad.
- 3. Homeowner Must Post A \$1,000 "Homeowner's Sidewalk & Drive Pad Bond" Using City's Approved Form. (Need Original) (City Ordinance 6-5-5-8-8) <u>Sidewalk</u> Ordinance
- 4. Homeowner Must Present Evidence of \$500,000 Liability Insurance Coverage on the Property Where the Concrete Work Is To Be Done.
- 5. Must Be Approved By The Excavation Permit Personnel.

Note: As Required By City Ordinance, Anyone Working In The City Right-of-Way Is Required To Obtain A Permit.
