According to the U.S. Coast Guard, Paddlesports, which include canoeing, kayaking, rafting, and stand up paddling (SUP), is the fastest growing area within recreational boating. With that popularity is a growing number of accidents. In its most recent statistics covering recreational boating, the U.S. Coast Guard reported over 134 fatalities relating to paddling accidents in 2011.

The New Mexico State Parks Division's Boating Safety office, has supported the work of the National Association of State Boating Administrators (NASBLA) and is proud to have one of the leading online boating safety educators bring you a free Paddlesports on-line safety course.

Kerry Moher, Vice President of BOATERexam.com and member of the NASBLA Education Standards Panel said that "Many of us are also avid paddlers. So we put two and two together and decided to create a free course that would help new enthusiasts enjoy the sport safely."

For over eight years, BOATERexam.com has been delivering an online safe boating course for New Mexico that leads to safety certifications required by all Jet Ski, powerboat and sailboat operator born on or after Jan. 1, 1989. It is not required for paddlecraft. However, "There are many safety risks unique to paddling," says Pamela Dillon, NASBLA Education Director and former head of the American Canoe Association. "For example, capsizing is far more frequent. Early in the season, the combination of cold water and an unexpected capsizing can be deadly. So we are excited to have an online course that can help us get that kind of message out."

"By making the course free of charge, we hope that many new paddlers will spend a few minutes to learn some basics before heading out on the water." Anytime is a good time to take the course," concludes Moher. To take the paddlesport course visit www.boaterexam.com/paddling.

Trends in boating accidents

- The 2012 fatality rate was **5.4** deaths per 100,000 registered recreational vessels. That's a 12.9 percent drop from the 2011 rate of 6.2 deaths per 100,000 registered recreational vessels.
- Overall, the number of accidents in 2012 decreased **1.6 percent** compared with 2011.
- Almost **71 percent** of all fatal boating accident victims drowned; of those, almost **85 percent** were not reported as wearing a life jacket.
- **Seven out of every 10** boaters who drowned were using vessels less than 21 feet in length.
