The City Adults Sports Program has adopted the following “COVID Compliance Acknowledgement” to provide a safer playing environment for all participants. Each rule will be STRICTLY enforced. No Exceptions. It is the team managers’ responsibility to ensure each participant know, and adheres to these rules.

- There will be a reduction in the number of scheduled softball games at each softball complex and field to promote COVID Safe Practices.
- Teams, league organizers and tournament directors are responsible to ensure adequate personal protective equipment (PPE) is used for player and spectator including: masks, hand sanitizer, disinfection products, etc.
- ***Masks are required for everyone at all times (including but not limited to spectators, players, captains, and umpires).***
- Social distancing is required for spectators.
- Dugout areas will be expanded to promote social distancing.
- Parking lot tailgating is not permitted.
- Teams will be required to disinfect high touch areas (bleachers, dugouts, team equipment) after games.
- Games will be scheduled with a minimum 45 minutes of “transition time” allowing for disinfection.
- Spectators will be limited to “color coded” field capacity limits.
- Teams will be required to provide disinfection supplies and hand sanitizer product.
- Coolers will not be allowed in the dugouts. Players must provide their own water bottles.
- Teams shall vacate the softball field and parking lot as quickly as possible at the end of the game, within the allotted transition time.
- A positive COVID-19 test result for a team player will result in a team suspension of play for the current CDC recommended quarantine period.
- Food trucks and on-site vending is not permitted.
- Chewing tobacco, bubblegum, and sunflower seed use is not allowed.

The City of Albuquerque, Parks & Recreation Division, and/or Recreation Services, reserve the right to add or delete any additional rules deemed necessary for the good and safety of every participant of the program. These rules are further subject to change if stricter terms are ordered by a State Public Health Order or a City of Albuquerque Declaration of Local Public Health Emergency. The undersigned agrees to abide by the aforementioned COVID Compliance Acknowledgement and fully waives all rights associated with the Code of Conduct.
