Agreement to attend FETCH-apalooza 2012

Co-hosted by the City of Albuquerque Animal Welfare Department and the Albuquerque Journal
Saturday, April 21 and Sunday, April 22 @ the Albuquerque Journal – 7777 Jefferson NE

Please read over the following rules carefully. Any shelter, rescue group or individual rescue that does not abide by the agreement may be asked to leave the event immediately and will not be asked to return to FETCH-apalooza in the future.

- Groups will not be allowed to show up or set up prior to Saturday, April 21 at 7:00 a.m.
- Groups are permitted to stay overnight on the grounds Saturday, April 21.
- Groups must provide their own kennels for the animals they bring.
- Animals must be kept clean and housed in a proper manner.
- Animals brought to the event may not be animal aggressive or sick.
- All animals must be spayed or neutered and micro-chipped.
- Groups are required to charge their normal adoption fees during the event. Inflated adoption fees will not be permitted.
- Each group is allowed to have a maximum of 40 animals on the premises at one time.
- Groups are expected to assist in keeping the grounds clean at all times and be diligent in cleaning up after the animals they are responsible for.
- Groups will not be permitted to hand out materials referencing Petsmart.
- Animal groups not bringing animals will be required to set up in the “educational” section in order to promote and educate the attendees on their mission, cause, etc.
