### 2-21-3 Policy

It is the policy of the Albuquerque Police Department (Department) to investigate any natural death or suicide to properly document the cause(s) of such death and ensure that no evidence is lost or concealed.

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### 2-21-42-21-5 Procedures

- A. Apparent Natural Death
- 1. For all apparent natural death calls, except calls where a death occurs in a hospital or nursing home, the dispatched officer will:
  - a. Check the body for signs of life.
  - b. Investigate the incident and complete the incident report, and the Apparent Natural Death Worksheet (PD 3066).
  - c. Attempt to contact the deceased's physician if it is known that the deceased was under a doctor's care.
  - d. Office of the Medical Investigator (OMI) will be called to all unattended deaths.
