11700-block of Tracy Ct NE: Punched door lock and stolen construction tools and clothing left in the unattended vehicle; also damaged a second vehicle's door lock, but did not gain entry to burglarize the vehicle.

11500-block of Candelaria Rd NE: 1159 hr. Unforced entry, stole registration and insurance documents.

- Quick Take-Away: Continuing to leave documents, tools, etc. inside unattended vehicles will make your vehicle an attractive target for auto burglary. Half the battle on the prevention side is to clear the vehicle of items of value and leave nothing visible, locking up when you walk away. The other half of the prevention side is to consider an alarm system, parking under good lighting and in areas where a passer-by could be a good witness and call 911 for a crime in progress. Of course, if you have a garage to park in that is a major preventative to being an auto burglary victim.
- Trail Heads: Our beautiful Foothills trail access parking areas may be becoming more active targets for auto burglary and auto theft as the weather cools down and more users come out to access trails. The Foothills Area Command is putting together a special project to help combat auto burglaries and thefts at these locations – I'll post about it soon so our community can get involved and partner with us on this project as we move closer to completion!
