Quick Take-Aways: As readers can see, auto burglary was our biggest issue yesterday. Take a look at the items that were left in unattended vehicles and ask yourself if you are making the same mistakes as yesterday's victims.

Have you cleared your vehicle and left nothing visible? Have you locked up? Do you park under lighting to discourage a burglar? Do you have a garage but you don't park there because it's filled with holiday decorations, yard equipment and junk? Do you have a car alarm? Does your foliage provide cover to a burglar? Are you and your neighbors up to date on crime prevention principles? Are neighbors willing to call 911 from a safe place if they were to see someone strange trying to get into your vehicle?

These are all things to think about and put into action to prevent being a victim of an auto burglar.
