

FUTURE INDICATORS

The Indicators Progress Commission identified several community conditions and related indicators considered to be important but for which data collection has begun recently and historic data are not yet available. For future Albuquerque Progress Reports and Interim Updates, the IPC will work closely with the City Department involved to add these indicators.

GOAL: Public Safety

DESIRED COMMUNITY CONDITIONS: Residents feel safe; Residents are safe.

INDICATOR:

The IPC will work with the Albuquerque Fire Department (AFD) to develop appropriate indicators relating to actual fire incidents and loss (lives and property), and response time, as well as EMS incidents, response time, and effectiveness. AFD has made a concerted effort to obtain and report important data, but this data have been available for one year only.

GOAL: Environmental Protection and Enhancement

DESIRED COMMUNITY CONDITIONS: Open space, bosque, the river, and mountains are preserved and protected..

INDICATOR:

The IPC will work with the Open Space Division of the Parks and Recreation Department to develop appropriate indicators relating to the health of the Open Space ecosystems.

The IPC appreciates the professional approach and responsiveness of the AFD and Parks and Recreation Department in addressing these issues and their continued successful efforts to address data needs.
