- **Virtualization Infrastructure Upgrade** - \$211,623.23 – DFAS - Ryan K. Gustafson
ITSD's goal with this virtualization project is to reduce total capital expenditure through increased server hardware consolidation. Research has shown that server hardware consolidation ratios of between 8:1 and 12:1 are already being achieved by many organizations as a result of implementing hyper visor technology (e.g., VMware ESXi). These benefits quite often—but not always—require an up-front capital investment which is then re-couped during the operational life of the asset. Some of the benefits will include synching with Disaster Recovery, no hardware to purchase for users, timeframe will quickened, great flexibility and maximum CPU time. **Mark Leech made motion to approve.
