These PC's will replace aging/obsolete equipment. Library 3M Intelligent Return System – Cultural Services – John F. Meier - \$34,715.00 - As part of the Library's RFID Migration, we would like to add a 3M Intelligent Return System to another one of our libraries. This easy-to-use intuitive interface allows library customers to instantly check their items in, helping speed their return to the shelves to be borrowed again. This technology eliminates much of the time that is spent accepting items at the front desk and clearing customer's records, so circulation staff can devote more time to serving customers.
