 - Location and attendance notes
 - Visited two sites Balloon Fiesta Sid Cutter Pavilion and South Broadway Cultural Center
 - South Broadway Cultural Center
 - Space: a tighter pre-program event, small reception in the lobby, then everyone moves to the auditorium/theater for the program
 - Set up: they would set up for us
 - Food: Heavy hors d'oeuvres is the max
 - o Capacity: 200-300
 - Parking: Can be tricky
 - Balloon Fiesta Sid Cutter Pavilion
 - Beautiful space but kind of far from the center of the city
 - Set up: we would be responsible for set up (all chairs, all tables, etc.), but they would do tear down. We would have to do trash pick up after event and dispose of trash
