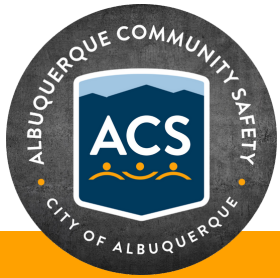

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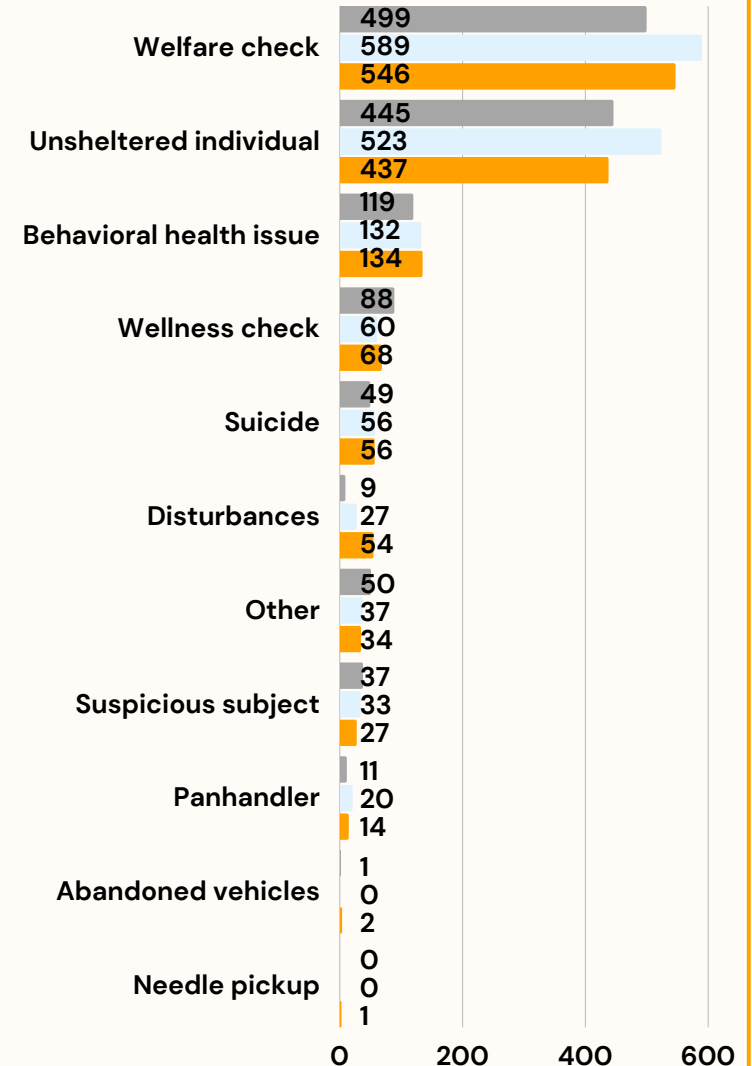

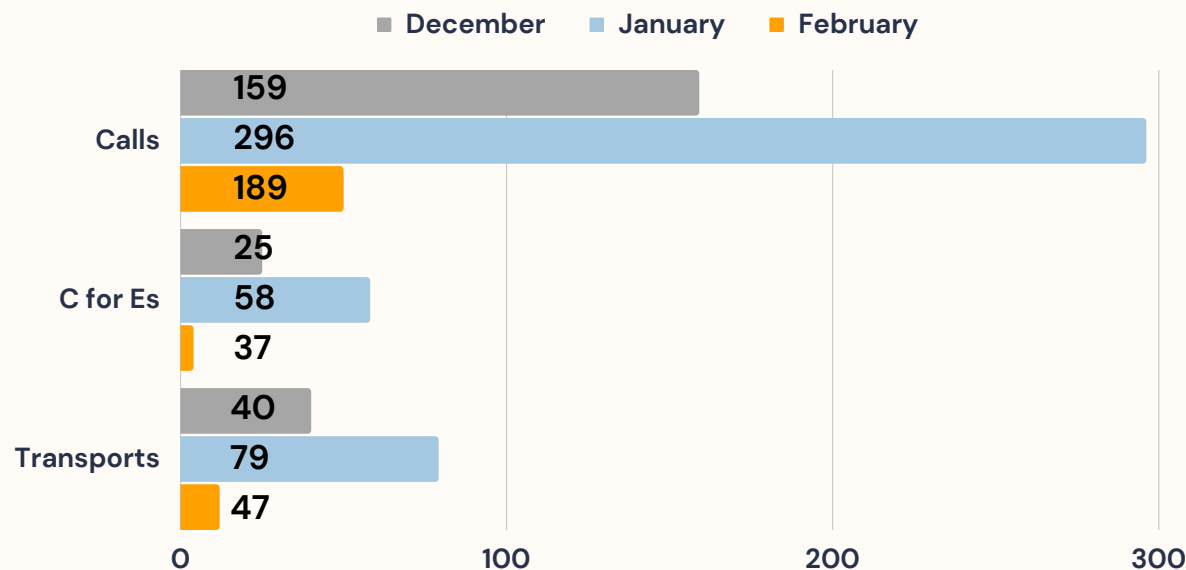

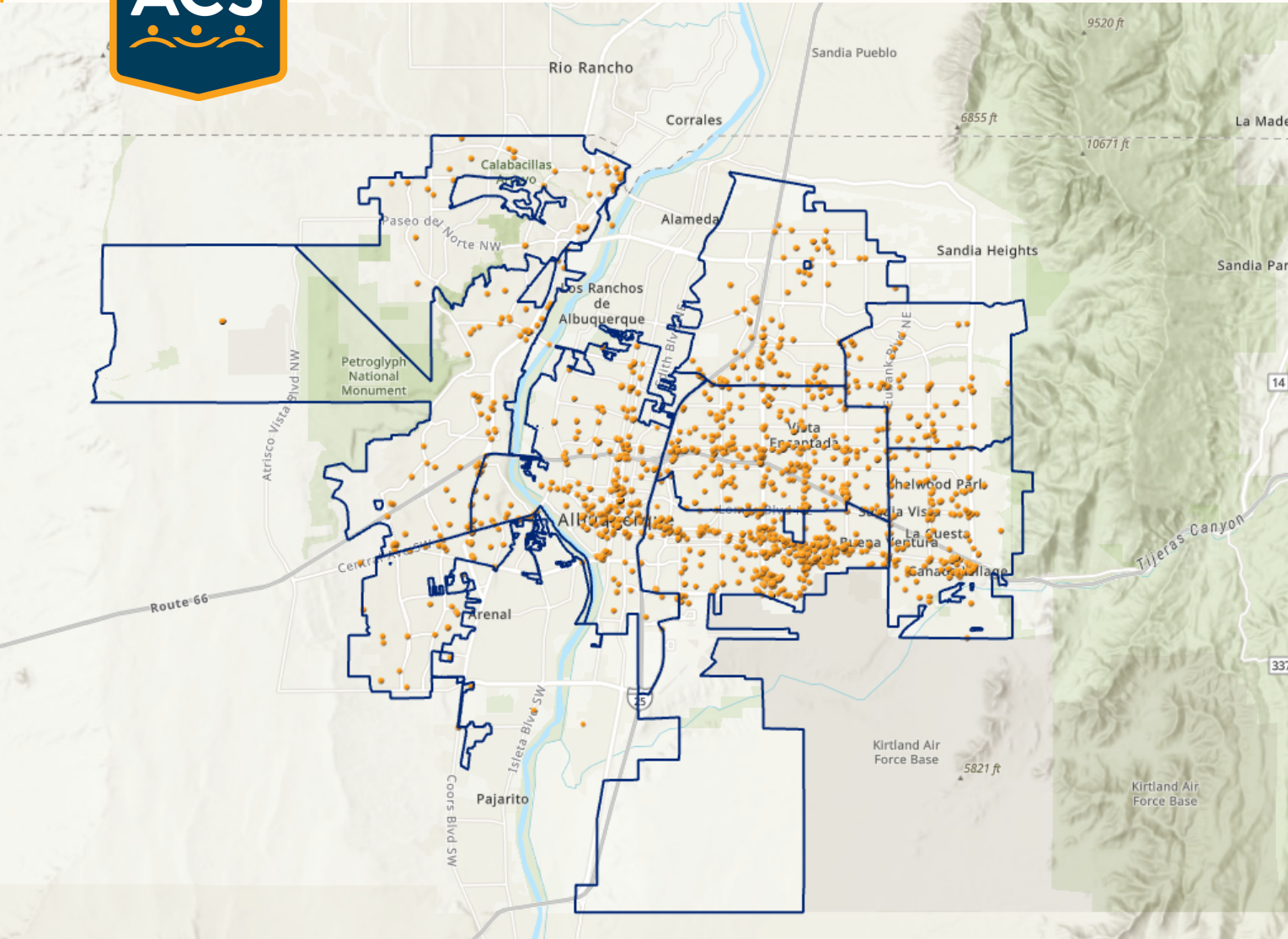

SIGNIFICANT RESPONSE ACTIVITIES

- The Community Oriented Response & Assistance team worked with several people affected by a double homicide – suicide in February near 12th and Griegos NW. CORA Responders made contact with 88 homes and three businesses in the area, offering each support and resources. CORA is now working with several people affected by the incident.
- Last month, CORA Responders helped those impacted by a homicide at Love's Travel Stop. Responders offered support and resources to staff.
- In February, CORA Responded to the victims of multiple armed robberies. Responders offered support and connections to services for each victim.
- CORA also assisted a family who lost their father to alcoholism. Responders guided the family through their loss and provided support and resources.

PROACTIVE AND ONGOING COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES

- CORA continues to attend monthly domestic violence and sexual assault commission meetings.
