ORDER UPHOLDING DIVISION'S DETERMINATION OF NO SIGNIFICANT PUBLIC INTEREST

This matter comes before the Board on a Mandate from the New Mexico Court of Appeals following the issuance of its November 26, 2014 Memorandum Opinion remanding the matter to the Board to consider the question of "whether Petitioners Toledo and Carrasco's request for a public hearing, together with the emailed questions received by EHD from the local neighborhood associations, constituted 'significant public interest' to necessitate a public hearing."

At its regularly scheduled meeting on July 8, 2015, the Board heard evidence and oral argument presented by Counsel for Smith's, the City's Air Quality Program, and Petitioners.

Having considered the evidence and arguments presented along with the written submittals and the administrative record, the Board upheld the Air Quality Program's determination of 'no significant public interest' on a vote of 5-0.

The Board's Dismissal of this appeal is now final.
