- - Emissions inventory requirements for tracking compliance with the SO₂ milestones
 - Requirements that apply to major sources of SO₂ emissions as a "backstop" regulatory program if specified milestones exceeded
 - Trigger for the procedures and compliance requirements for sources in the trading program

Reasons for Proposed Amendments to 20.11.46 NMAC

- Compliance with 40 CFR § 51.309
- National goal for visibility protection
- ~ 2008 amendments have not been approved by EPA
- Backstop trading rules must be consistent across all "309 states"

- "WEB Emissions and Allowance Tracking System" / "WEB EATS"

- Clarifying that "retirement" of a source must be "permanent"

PETITION TO AMEND 20.11.46 NMAC

- Amend 20.11.46 NMAC, Sulfur Dioxide Emissions Inventory Requirements; Western Backstop Sulfur Dioxide Trading Program, and incorporate amendments into the SIP
 - Request for a hearing
 - Court reporter
 - Hearing officer
 - Hearing will take approximately 1 hour or less

PETITION TO AMEND 20.11.46 NMAC

- **Authority**
- **New Mexico Air Quality Control Act**
 - authorizes and requires the Air Board to adopt, amend, or replace air quality regulations and to adopt air quality plans (SIPs)
