# Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Air Quality Control Board



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## MINUTES – April 9, 2025

This Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Air Quality Control Board (“Board”) meeting was conducted in a virtual format via Zoom video conference.

### I. CALL TO ORDER

Chair Galewsky called the meeting to order at 5:31 p.m.

Board Liaison Anita SdeArmijo called roll and the Chair determined a quorum was present.

Present: 7 – Dennis Armijo, Jane Cudney-Black, Thomas De Pree, Joseph Galewsky, Josephine Lopez, Nancy Montaña, Kitty Richards

Absent: 0

Chair Galewsky welcomed the newest new board member, Josephine Lopez, and she briefly spoke about her background.

Air Program Administrator Catalina Lehner gave the Zoom overview.

### II. CONSENT AGENDA *(Items may be removed at the request of any Board Member)*

#### A. Approval of the April 9, 2025 Meeting Agenda

Vice Chair Richards stated that she had a couple of changes for the March minutes. Chair Galewsky asked if there was a motion to approve the consent agenda with the proposed change. Member Armijo moved and Member Cudney-Black seconded. The motion passed by the following vote:

#### B. Approval of the March 12, 2025 Minutes

Vice Chair Richards explained the requested changes to the minutes and asked staff to make them. Member Lopez moved to approve the March 12, 2025 Minutes. Member De Pree seconded and the motion passed by the following vote:

Member De Pree seconded and the motion passed by the following vote:

#### B. Presentation and Action on the final 2023 SO<sub>2</sub> Milestone Report in Accordance with the Section 309 Regional Haze State Implementation Plan Element, Section A3.10 (Allen Smith, Regulation Development Coordinator)

Mr. Smith gave a short presentation on the Milestone report and stood for questions. After discussion, Member Cudney-Black moved to accept the final 2023 SO<sub>2</sub> Milestone Report. Member Galewsky seconded. The motion passed by the following vote:

#### C. AQCB 2025-01: Petition to Amend Existing Rule 20.11.8 NMAC - Ambient Air Quality Standards (Catalina Lehner, AQP Administrator)

Ms. Lehner gave a summary of the petition and stood for questions. After a brief discussion, Member Cudney-Black moved to grant a hearing at the June 11<sup>th</sup> air board meeting at 5:30 p.m.

D. - The board will discuss, make a motion with reasonable specificity, and vote whether or not to go into closed session, following procedures outlined in Section 10-15-1 (I) of the OMA. Exceptions to open meetings are outlined in Section 10-15-1 (H).

Vice Chair Richard moved to go into closed session to discuss litigation. Member Lopez seconded. The motion passed by the following vote:

Against: 0      Abstain: 1- Cudney-Black      Absent: 0

The Board was in closed session from 6:46-7:42 p.m. After coming out of closed session, Chair Armijo stated that the board discussed the pending litigation and did not vote.



Chair Armijo adjourned the meeting at 7:57 p.m.


