

# Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Air Quality Control Board



# MINUTES – September 10, 2025

This Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Air Quality Control Board ("Board") meeting was conducted in a hybrid format via Zoom video conference.

#### I. CALL TO ORDER

Vice Chair Richards called the meeting to order at 5:31 p.m.

Board Liaison Anita SdeArmijo called roll and the Vice Chair determined a quorum was present.

Absent: 1 - Dennis Armijo

Members Cudney-Black, De Pree, Galewsky, and Lopez attended via Zoom.

Member Montaño moved to approve the agenda as written. Member Lopez seconded. The motion passed by the following vote:

B. Approval of the August 13, 2025 Minutes

Member Montaño moved to approve the August 13, 2025 minutes. Member Cudney-black seconded. The motion passed by the following vote:

A. Clarification of the Board's authority regarding the representation of Isleta Pueblo on the Overburdened Areas (OBA) map and possible vote regarding the June 30, 2025 vote.

Board counsel Jane Yee gave an overview of the topic. After a lengthy discussion, Vice Chair Richards moved that the Board rescind the June 30, 2025 vote, and the order embedded in the June 30<sup>th</sup> oral vote due to the Board's lack of authority to vote and issue that order, and that the Board's vote and order on June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2025 are null and void from their inception. Member Cudney-Black seconded. The motion passed by the following vote:

B. Presentation of Board Counsel of an outline pertaining to Board authority, planning, regulatory roles and responsibilities.

Board attorney Jane Yee stated that her outline was not finished, but spoke on the content she would like to include and her intent to work with Air Program Administrator Catalina Lehner on this.

#### VI. CLOSED SESSION

Vice Chair Richards asked if a board member would like to make a motion for the Advanced Clean Vehicles case. Hearing none, no vote was taken.

Vice Chair Richards moved to go into closed session for the rest of the cases. Member Lopez seconded. The motion passed by the following vote:

Against: 0 Abstain: 2- Cudney-Black, De Pree Absent: 1 – Armijo

Members Cudney Black and De Pree left the zoom after the vote.
