Air Quality Monitoring

- Since 1972 Environmental Health has operated Air Monitoring network in Bernalillo Co.
- Currently operate 6 stations county wide to establish that the area complies with National Air Quality Standards
- Monitor for Ozone, CO, NO₂, SO₂, PM₁₀, PM_{2.5}, Lead



2014 Annual Network Review

- Annual network review submitted in July
- EPA Region VI either accepts or suggests changes
- Posted for 30 days public review & comment
- Region VI appears to be moving in the direction of minimum requirements

Proposed for 2014



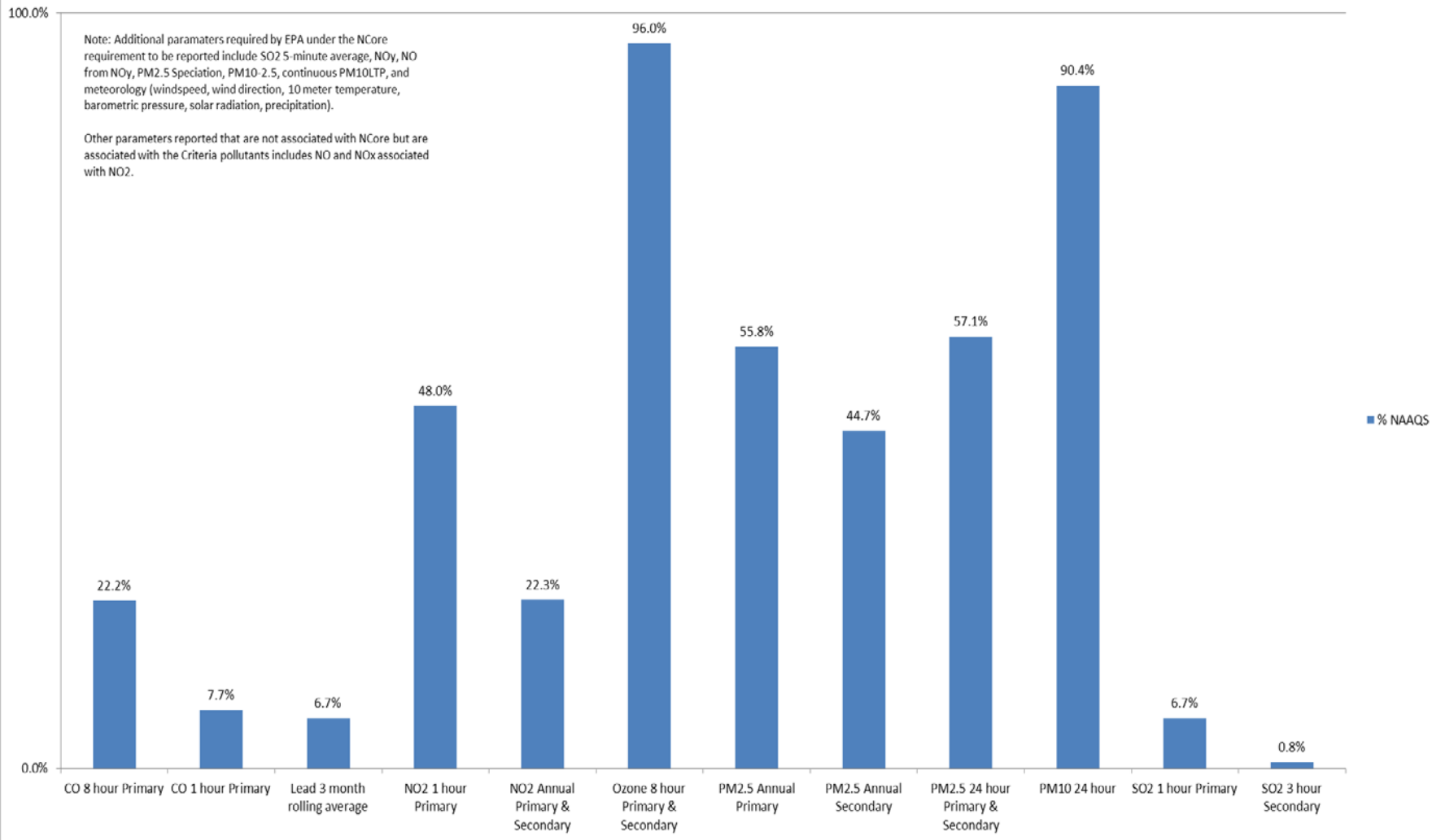


Air Quality Network

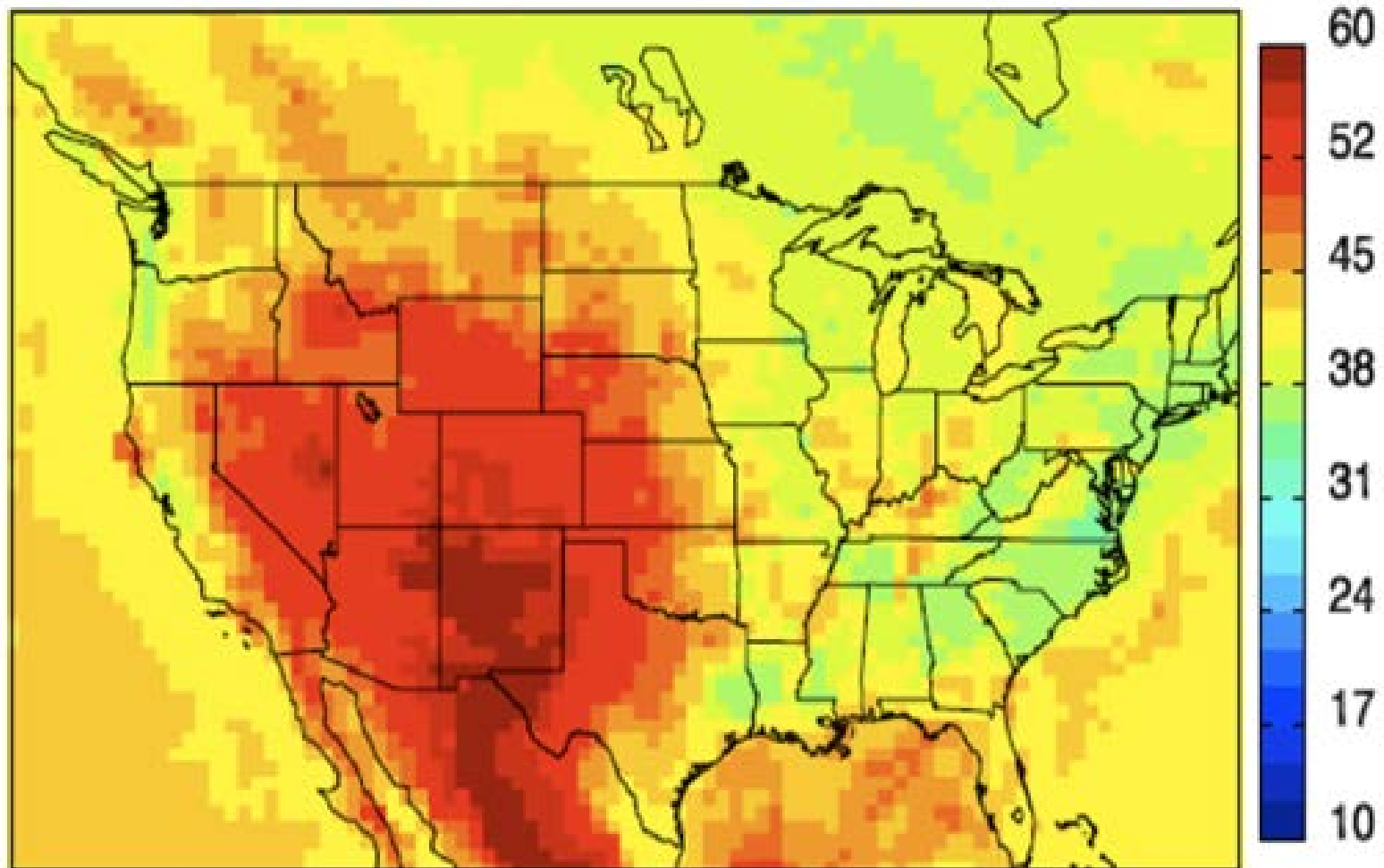
- Mid-level monitors
- Network is designed to provide attainment status of NAAQS (not to provide site-specific information)
- Albuquerque/Bernalillo County area in compliance with all NAAQS
