Annual Report to the Albuquerque Bernalillo County Air Quality Control Board July 8, 2015

The Oxygenated Fuel Program

- Air pollution control strategy to reduce tailpipe emissions
 - Accomplished by blending ethanol with gasoline
 - Required minimum 2.7% oxygen content by weight during the "Winter pollution season"
 - November 1 to end of February
 - 20% retail stations are sampled and tested
- New Mexico Department of Agriculture
 - 144 retail stations out of 240 (60%)
 - Average oxygen content by weight was 8.9%
