DRAFT MEETING MINUTES

CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order by Chair Dr. Dona Upson at 5:37 p.m. on October 9, 2013 with six voting Board members and two non-voting members present: Chair Dr. Dona Upson, M.D., Ms. Kelsey Curran, Ms. Jane Cudney-Black, Mr. Jens Deichmann, Dr. Naomi Kistin, M.D., Mr. Jack Sullivan, Mr. Lenton Malry, Ph.D., and Ms. Margaret Nieto. Absent from the meeting was Dr. Robert Goldstein, M.D.

Item #1 Approval of Agenda (Chair)

Member Curran moved to approve the agenda, followed by a second to the motion by Ms. Cudney-Black. The motion was approved unanimously.

Item #2 Approval of September 11, 2013 Meeting Minutes (Chair)

A motion to approve the September 11, 2013 meeting minutes was made by Member Deichmann, seconded by Member Cudney-Black, and was approved unanimously.

Neal Butt presented the AQCB Petition No. 2013-7 to the Air Board, explaining why the amendments and requests are being made. A motion was made by Member Jens Deichmann to approve the request for a hearing. The motion was seconded by Member Cudney-Black, and then approved unanimously by the Board.

Ms. Watkins and Mr. Sussman presented the material they had prepared and entertained questions from the Board. Among the questions and discussion was whether there is anything the Air Board could do to promote a bicycle-sharing program in the City of Albuquerque (by Chair Upson). Members Jens Deichmann and Jane Cudney-Black volunteered to draft a letter to the Mayor and the City Council on behalf of the Air Board, asking that a bicycle-sharing program be developed and funded for the City of Albuquerque. Ms. Watkins and Mr. Sussman added that MRCOG could help to identify the scope and locations for such a program, as they have a member of their staff who works on that.
