Proposed State Boards SIP Revision

- CAA Section 128(a) State Boards [§7428, U.S.C.A.]
 - (1) any board or body which approves permits or enforcement orders under the Act shall have at least a majority of members who represent the public interest and do not derive any significant portion of their income from persons subject to permits or enforcement orders under the Act, and
 - (2) any potential conflicts of interest by members of such board or body, or the head of an executive agency with similar powers, be adequately disclosed.

Proposed State Boards SIP Revision

- **NM Air Quality Control Act [Section 74–2–4]**
- Authorizes Albuquerque - Bernalillo County to locally administer and enforce the Air Quality Control Act by providing for a local air quality control program.
- State law views Albuquerque - Bernalillo County as a distinct air quality control entity, separate from the remainder of the State of New Mexico.
- Each entity is required to submit its own SIP revision in order to completely satisfy the requirements of Section 128(a) of the CAA for the entire State of New Mexico.

Proposed State Boards SIP Revision

- EPA approved SIP revision for Board composition and conflict of interest disclosure requirements on 6/1/1999, effective 8/2/1999.
- Since then ordinances have been revised.
- Air Quality Division is proposing to update the SIP to incorporate the latest City of Albuquerque and Bernalillo County Ordinances regarding board composition and conflict of interest as it applies to the Air Board.

- Adopt proposed “State Boards SIP” [AQD Exhibit # 1a], as amended by Staff Proposed Floor Amendments [AQD Exhibit # 15]
- Submit the SIP to EPA as a proposed revision to the New Mexico State Implementation Plan for Air Quality (SIP)
