CALL TO ORDER

Chair Meiklejohn called the meeting to order at 5:31 p.m. Vice Chair Paul, Member Langner and Member Richards were absent. The Chair found that there was no quorum, so the Board was unable to conduct official business. Members present opted to take reports. The following reports were presented:
