Open burning activities of Kirtland Air Force Base

Annual, multiple event permits

- 200 lbs or less of explosives
- Firefighter training: up to 300 gallons of propane

Single event permits April 2008 – March 2009

- 32 permits for destroying explosives
 - * 1200 1300 lbs of waste explosives, 300 lbs of C-4 or 10 gallons of diesel

 1 permit for detonating 1450 lbs of ANFO for Applied Research Associates

What does 'waste' mean?

Ammunition that cannot be used

 "no chemicals or solvents are burned at Kirtland" – NMED Haz. Waste Bureau

Actual explosives destroyed April 2008- April 2009

24,213 lbs

• 18 explosions, 2 burns

Alternative

Transport and destroy somewhere else.
The risk isn't worth the effort.

Permitting process

- Compare request/application to Tables I&II in open burn regulation.
 - Often, citizens just want to burn a pile of weeds, leaves, branches, etc. and don't need a permit.
- Use a database to store information and generate paper permit.
