Air Quality Control Board July 2021 Meeting Acting Director's Air Quality Written Report: Updates from the Last Month

The Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Joint Air Quality (AQ) Program, administered by the City of Albuquerque's Environmental Health Department (EHD), is authorized to implement and enforce clean air laws within the boundaries of the City of Albuquerque and Bernalillo County.

EHD Responds to EPA Audits-

- **FY 2019 Grant-** On 04/28/2021, after receiving a new, 24-hour deadline from EPA, EHD provided answers to financial discrepancies found in EPA's initial review of EHD's FY 2019 105 grant. The discrepancies were explained and this audit is complete.
- **Title V Fees-** On 04/27/2021, EHD provided answers to 35 questions posed by EPA regarding EHD's Title V fees and how they are managed.
- **Technical Systems Audit** In the last month, EHD has answered many questions posed by EPA regarding the monitoring system.

EHD Approves Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Water Utility Authority (ABCWUA) Emergency Permit Application – On 06/03/2021, EHD received ABCWUA's application for an emergency permit regarding its Southside Wastewater Treatment Plant. EHD's Acting Director approved this application to protect public health.

EHD Receives Request for Enforcement Hearing– On 05/27/21, EHD issued a compliance order to Guzman Construction, LLC. (Broadway Railroad Stockpiles) for not installing fugitive dust control measures, not cleaning up track-out, and for importing material from an unauthorized site. On 06/15/21, EHD received Guzman's response and request for a hearing regarding the compliance order issued on 5/27/21.

EHD Issues Notice of Violation (NOV) to Salls Brothers Construction, Inc (Lavender Fields) – On 07/01/21, EHD issued an NOV to Salls Brothers Construction, Inc. for failing to use reasonably available fugitive dust control measures.

EHD Settles NOVs with Permittees-

- On 06/14/21, EHD settled with City's Department of Municipal Development (DMD) for initiating surface disturbance at the International District Library without a fugitive dust permit.
- On 06/08/21, EHD settled with American Gypsum, LLC. for constructing a regulated emission source prior to modifying their permit and for a late compliance test.
- On 06/10/21, EHD settled with DMD regarding their emergency generator at 1 Civic Plaza.
- On 06/24/21, EHD settled with Monarch Properties for not doing a thorough inspection for the presence of asbestos prior to initiating renovation activities at Encino Pl. Apt.
- On 06/29/21, EHD settled with Lovelace Biomedical Research Institute for constructing and operating a regulated emission source prior to modifying its permit.
- On 07/03/21, EHD settled with T&M Storage, LLC. for initiating surface disturbance without a fugitive dust permit.

EHD Issues Compliance Order to Permittee- On 05/27/21, EHD issued a compliance order to Guzman Construction, LLC. (Broadway Railroad Stockpiles) for not installing fugitive dust control measures, not cleaning up track-out and for importing material from an unauthorized site.

EHD Continues to Update the AQ Program Website- This month, EHD created a clear path to the following two pages: <u>Public Notices and Comment Opportunities for Regulatory Development</u> and <u>Public Notices and Comment Opportunities for Air Board matters</u>.
