Construction Permit for Albuquerque Metals Recycling

Albuquerque Metals Recycling, Inc. has submitted a construction air quality permit application, to modify Authorityto-Construct #1529-M2, to the Air Quality Program (Program) of the City of Albuquerque Environmental Health Department. Albuquerque Metals Recycling is requesting to update their permit to account for all of the conveyor drop points, screens and storage piles at their facility. In addition they want to add one (1) aboveground gasoline storage tank and one (1) hammermill grinder. The facility is located at 3339 Second Street SW in Albuquerque, New Mexico. The owner of this facility is Albuquerque Metals Recycling, Inc., 3339 Second Street SW, Albuquerque, NM 87105. This application file has been assigned Permit #1529-M3.

The facility will consist of one (1) hammermill shredder, twenty-two (22) conveyor drop points, one (1) cyclone for dust suppression, eight (8) screens, one (1) hammermill grinder, one (1) aboveground gasoline storage tank, storage piles and plant haul roads.

The maximum air pollution emissions to the atmosphere from this facility have been estimated to be: Total Suspended Particulates (TSP) – 3.76 lb/hr – 16.45 tpy, 10 Micron Particulate Matter (PM_{10}) – 2.01 lb/hr – 13.18 tpy, 2.5 Micron Particulate Matter ($PM_{2.5}$) – 1.86 lb/hr – 12.29 tpy, Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC)– 0.01 lb/hr – 0.06 tpy

A copy of the permit application is available for inspection by the public at the Program offices. Interested persons may submit written comments and evidence, request a public information hearing, or both on the permit application to the Program. Comments will be accepted and considered if postmarked by the end of the public comment period on May 6, 2016. Formal action on the application will be reserved pending receipt and analysis of any additional details or information developed during the public comment period.

The Program shall hold a Public Information Hearing pursuant to 20.11.41.15 NMAC if the Director determines there is significant public interest and a significant air quality issue is involved.

The Program expects to issue, issue subject to conditions, or deny this application before June 30, 2016. Any person who does not participate in the permitting action will not receive notification of the Program's decision regarding the proposed permit, unless the person has delivered a written request for notice to the Program.
