CALL TO ORDER

Deputy Director Danny Nevarez called the meeting to order at 6:00pm and announced the following:

- EHD is applying for the EPA Community Scale Grant of \$750,000 – No award yet.
- EHD will be proposing to add a monitoring station in San Jose community. The proposal will be included in the 2018 Annual Network Review.
- As a result of EHD's request, EPA concurred to reinstate the North Valley Monitoring station.
- Air Quality Coalition would like to be as transparent as possible. Live streaming was rolled out on Facebook on the July 19, 2017 Coalition meeting, which had over 15,000 views.
- Emissions Inventory reporting has increased from 18% in 2013 to 93% in 2016.
- Air Quality Program's collection and billings for the Stationary Source annual fees have increased to 99%.

ITEM #1: Demonstration of Inspection

EHD employees, Mr. Mike McKinstry and Ms. Holly Huffines demonstrated the use of the GS300 infrared camera (Camera). They demonstrated that the Camera can be used for stationary source inspection. Their demonstration covered the following topics:

- Camera use and its benefits during inspection;
- Detecting fluid level in tanks;
- Infrared photos and video recordings;
- Detecting temperature differences which allows the user to view and record substances that can't be seen with naked eye; and
- Range and sensitivity settings for viewing episodes up 50 feet.

ITEM #2: Working Session (Dr. Stringer)

Dr. Chelle Stringer continued discussion from the July 19, 2017 Coalition meeting on the indicators of success for the Coalition. Ms. Stringer asked Coalition members to discuss and come up with problem statements and potential projects to identify air quality issues that the Coalition could address.

Coalition Members voted on which problem to work on first.

The final vote selected was determined to be "cumulative impacts" as the first project to be addressed by the Coalition.

Coalition members agreed that any interested members would present relevant data on cumulative impacts for discussion at the next Coalition meeting.
