

Asbestos NESHAP Filing Requirements Flowchart *



- <u>Demolition</u>: removal of any load-supporting structural member, or intentional burning of, any facility
- **Renovation**: altering a facility in any way, including stripping or removal of RACM
- RACM (Regulated asbestos-containing material): ALL friable asbestos material, Category I nonfriable ACM that is now friable, Category I nonfriable ACM that will be or was subjected to sanding, grinding, cutting, or abrading, or Category II nonfriable ACM that has a high probability of becoming or has become crumbled, pulverized, or reduced to powder by forces expected to act on material in course of demolition or renovation operations
- <u>Category I nonfriable ACM</u>: asbestos-containing packings, gaskets, resilient floor covering, & asphalt roofing products containing more than 1% asbestos
- <u>Category II nonfriable ACM</u>: material, excluding Category I nonfriable ACM, containing more than 1% asbestos that, when dry, cannot be crumbled, pulverized, or reduced to powder by hand pressure

NOTES:

- Prior to demolition or renovation, a <u>thorough inspection</u>, to include lab work (as applicable), must be conducted at facility by a <u>LICENSED ASBESTOS INSPECTOR</u> & notification must be submitted certifying to presence or absence of ACM, even if RACM is not or may not be present in facility
- Owner/operator is responsible for ensuring ACM does not become RACM, unless it is accounted for in NESHAP & fees are paid (if applicable)
