	Report and Final Report. (1). The owner or operator shall file an initial report, no later than the end of the next regular business day after the discovery of an excess emission. The initial report shall include all available information regarding each item required by Subsection B of 20 NMAC. (2). No later than 10 days after the end of the excess emission, the owner or operator shall file a final report that contains specific and information for each item required by Subsection B of 20.11.49.15 NMAC.  The appropriate supplemental report described in Subsections A, B, or C of 20.1.49.16 NMAC must be submitted to the department no later to
