

Re: 20.11.47 NMAC, Emissions Inventory Requirements

Dear Stakeholders:

The Air Quality Division for the City of Albuquerque is in the process of developing a new regulation 20.11.47 NMAC, Emissions Inventory Requirements. We would like your input as a stakeholder regarding this regulation and would appreciate your review and comments.

The scope of 20.11.47 NMAC applies to each person who owns or operates a source or who intends to construct or modify a source within Bernalillo County. "Source" is defined at Subsection X of 20.11.47.7 NMAC. The objective of 20.11.47 NMAC is to establish the requirements both for submitting inventories of air contaminants to comply with the Air Quality Control Act and the Federal Act, and for gathering data to quantify greenhouse gas emissions in Bernalillo County.
