**FINAL ORDER**

Vulcan Materials Company, Inc. seeks a Minor Source Air Quality Authority-To-Construct Permit for a concrete batching facility in the South Valley of Albuquerque, New Mexico.

The City of Albuquerque Air Quality Division supports the issuance of the permit with conditions necessary to protect public health and welfare and the environment.
