1. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Stephen J. Vogel at 12:06 p.m. with four members present. A quorum was present to conduct business.

3. **Old Business**

Report on the process for hiring the next Albuquerque Housing Authority Executive Director.

Chairperson Vogel announced that a list of candidates was created by Evett Birdsong to facilitate the Board's search. Member McHard, Chairperson Vogel and Associate Director Andrew Estocin met to review the applications and are now ready to discuss and review with the entire board to start the selection process.

"Limited personnel matters" exception" If a public policy-making body desires to meet in executive session to discuss an individual employee's dismissal, promotion, resignation, complaint or shortcomings, then such a meeting could properly be closed pursuant to the "limited personnel matters" exception set forth in Subsection H(2). 1990 Op. Att'y Gen. No. 90-28.

The Board members moved to a closed session into the small conference room across the hallway. The only people allowed in the Closed Session were Robin Dozier Otten, Andrew Estocin and Brian Eagan.

5. Re-Convene in Open Session

The Open Session re-convened at 1:07 p.m. in the Manuel Cordova Conference Room, and Chairperson Vogel, certified that the Board only discussed a limited personnel matter during the closed session, and no other business, and that no voting occurred during the closed session.

Chairperson Vogel discussed canceling the Regular Meeting set for September 19, 2012 and reschedule a Special Meeting on September 26, 2012 to discuss the interview process for the Executive Director job.

- D) Member McHard moved that the Regular Agenda items for a Regular Meeting of the Board be added to the Special Meeting Agenda on September 26, 2012. The motion was seconded by Vice Chairperson Growney, and the motion was carried by a vote of 4-0.
