

EASY (FAKE) TIN FRAMES

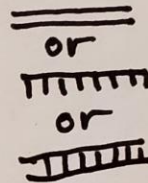
MATERIALS

- "Tin" rectangles (about 4" x 5")
Use recycled from pie plates or purchased
- + scrap pieces for practice
- 2" x 2 1/2" light cardboard rectangles
- Tooling tools
 - Dead ball point
 - Dull pencil
 - Sharp sticks
- Pointy scissors, rulers, staplers
- Pictures to frame

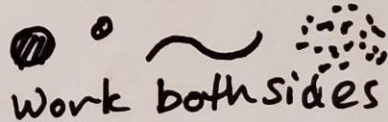


④ DECORATE

- Frame edges

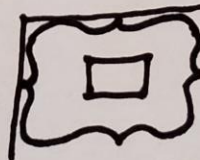


- Techniques



Work both sides

- Variations



- Trim the edges



- Add color w/ permanent marker
Red and green are traditional

- Cut the center X and roll the triangles over a stick



- Glue/Staple in a picture

HOW TO

- ① Trace an X on the aluminum 
- ② Trace an X on the cardboard rectangle 
- ③ Align the cardboard X over the tin X and trace the rectangle
