- Will discuss the naming of the physical space and the names will have term limits
- The architects are re-thinking the amphitheater space

### VI Report on complexity of the O'Keeffe and Moore installation, Andrew Connors

Andrew Connors reported:

- From the beginning with opening organizations, administrative planning, loan fees the museum was very much involved
- 20 people supervising the unpacking of objects
- Conservators on-site hired by the museum
- Very short list of people to enter the gallery during install
- Two security guards at all times
- Our team is heroic, finished install two days early
- Received praise from London, San Diego and National Gallery of Art
- Took an incredible amount of planning with security and city employees

### **VII Museum Director Report, Andrew Connors**

Andrew Connors reported:

- New security system through the City
  - 4 locations have access to cameras: Director, Asst. Director, Security Office and Front Desk
  - Use footage if there are incidents or protests about the way someone was treated
  - Thank you Cyndy Garcia and Shelle Sanchez
- Museum Staff
  - Asst. Director position will be filled on January 15, 2024. Bibi Baloyra came highly recommended.
  - Curator of Collections position is vacant. Michelle Lanteri took another job.
  - o Asst. Curator of Education position is vacant. Jessica Coyle resigned.

- Third Thursday programming is a very dynamic community experience and will continue
- Working on ways to keep going Jessica had a wonderful structure in place
- Museum Guide Training over 100 volunteers
- Over 130 school tours scheduled

- Coast to Coast, Pennsylvania Academy of Fine Arts, and Broken Boxes exhibitions coming up
- Asked everyone to visit O'Keeffe and Moore, Journalism and Dictators before they close
- Described the \$250,000 IMLS Grant Two people to assist in cataloging and photo archives
