Whereas, The Albuquerque Museum of Art and History shares stories of our rich heritage and many cultures, bringing Albuquerque to the world and the world to Albuquerque with more than 135,000 visitors annually; and

Whereas, we look back with pride at the 50 years of accomplishments and service of The Albuquerque Museum of Art and History and look forward to its expanding success in the future; and

Now, Therefore, I, Richard J. Berry, Mayor of the City of Albuquerque, do hereby proclaim September 7, 2017 as:
