Family Art from Home

Autumn Crown by Radka Apostalon

Create a crown to celebrate the arrival of autumn using natural materials gathered near your home.

Supplies Needed

- Cereal box or Card stock (1 wider strip, 2 or more narrow and shorter strips)
- Hot glue or Tacky Glue
- Stapler
- Scissors
- One sheet of tissue paper

How to Do It

1. On your walk in the park or from your garden collect leaves, acorns, dry flower heads and anything that you find suitable for making your autumnal crown.

2. From a cereal box or card stock paper, cut one wider strip that will fit comfortably around your head as a base for your crown. You might need to join two strips to get the desired length. Staple or hot glue the ends.

3. Cut two or more narrower strips to create a dome that you will later cover with tissue paper and the materials you have collected. Attach to the base with stapler or hot glue

4. Cover the dome with tissue paper and glue to the inside of the base. Start adding your treasures covering the entire surface of the tissue paper. The arrangement can be as wild or sophisticated as you wish.
